Answer 2: The stamped cement concrete pavement shall receive antiquing release agent and sealer (including additive) application using Butterfield Color #PT12 Perma-Tique Antiquing Agent – Storm Grey and Butterfield Color Clear-Guard cure and seal or approved equal.

Question 3: There is a "WA State Sales Tax" line item on the bid proposal. Does this bid follow "Rule 171"?

Answer: Yes, this bid follows Rule 171.

Question 4: The Specials in Section 2-02.5 state pay items for "Cement Conc Sidewalk Removal" and "Cement Conc Curb Removal" but no bid items were provided. Please advise.

Answer 4: The "Cement Conc Sidewalk Removal" and "Cement Conc Curb Removal" were added to Section 2-02.5 in error. These items are not on the bid items list.

Question 5: There are no bid items for 6" Concrete Sidewalk and "Stamped Concrete Pavement Pattern". Please provide bid items.

Answer 5: The bid item for Stamped Concrete Pavement was added as Item No. 47. The 6" Concrete Sidewalk is covered under Item #42: Cement Concrete Sidewalk.
