### FREE TO RECYCLE

#### BATTERIES - HOUSEHOLD

AAAA, AAA, AA, A, C, D cell alkaline batteries, button batteries, rechargeable batteries.

**NOT ACCEPTED:** Lithium-ion batteries like tool and vape. Visit [www.call2Recycle.org](http://www.call2Recycle.org) for more battery recycling options.

#### BATTERIES - LEAD-ACID

Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle.

#### ELECTRONICS

- Cell phones
- DVD players
- Fax machines
- Keyboards
- Laptops
- Mice
- Microwave
- Printers
- Scanners
- Tablets
- VCR

**NOT ACCEPTED:** TVs, computers, and monitors. Find free drop-off locations at [www.ecyclewa.org](http://www.ecyclewa.org).

#### PAINT - OIL & LATEX (25 GALLON MAX.)

All products must be in original container, with original label, and in liquid form. Cans do not need to be full. Visit [www.paintcare.org](http://www.paintcare.org) for more recycling options.

#### SCRAP METAL

- Auto parts
- BBQs
- Bikes
- Engines
- Ferrous & non-ferrous metals
- Lawn mowers (drain fluids)
- Household appliances
- Water heaters (\$5 each with insulated coating)

**NOT ACCEPTED:** Rubber/oil-coated; contaminated paint, oil, chemicals, gas, or hazardous materials; electrical ballasts; sealed drums.

#### SCRAP WOOD & LOGS (2 LOADS PER HOUSEHOLD)

Clean, (not painted, stained, or treated).

- Branches >6" diameter
- Logs
- Pallets
- Plywood

**NOT ACCEPTED:** Painted/stained wood, particle board, small branches, and brush.

### CASH ONLY CHARGE TO RECYCLE

#### CFC APPLIANCES

Refrigerators, freezers, and air conditioners.

**FEE:** \$35 each item

#### MATTRESSES & BOX SPRINGS

Clean and dry, any size, and please cover in the event of rain.

**NOT ACCEPTED:** Futons, wet or soiled items, furniture, frames.

**FEE:** \$35 each item

#### PORCELAIN TUBS, TOILETS, & SINKS

Remove seats, hardware, and base wax rings.

**FEE:** \$25 each item

#### PROPANE TANKS

**FEE:** Empty residential (\$10 each) and camping (\$1 each).

#### STYROFOAM BLOCKS & PACKING PEANUTS

- Clean and dry white expanded polystyrene blocks
- Packing peanuts (any color) all materials must be clean and dry. **NO TAPE, STICKERS, OR LABELS.**

**NOT ACCEPTED:** Foam cushions, hot tub covers, and insulation.

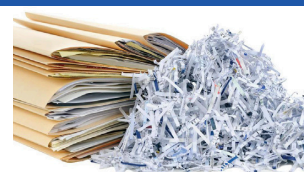
**FEE:** \$10 per vehicle load

#### TIRES - PASSENGER & TRUCK **NO TIRES ON RIMS** (FEES APPLY, 6 PER VEHICLE MAX.)

- 18" or below off rim - FREE
- \$3 for extra tires off rim
- \$10 fee for each truck tire off rim

**NOT ACCEPTED:** Oversized tires or tires on rims.

### FREE SHREDDING



Shredding and recycling of confidential paper materials. Staples OK. No binder clips.  
**Limit:** 4 file-size (12"x12"x16") boxes or 5 paper grocery bag per car. No exceptions.
